## KRZYKUCHA. STAND UP (FOR YOUR RIGHTS) COMEDY

Jana Shostak (Belarus), Komuna Warszawa (Warsaw/Poland)

According to Jana Shostak: "The Belarusian Revolution, which has been ongoing since August 2020, is rarely a joking matter – especially for its repressed participants. I, being a Belarussian who put one foot into protests against Lukashenko and the other into organising humanitarian help for the oppressed, have tears in my eyes much more often than a smile on my lips. An insider's perspective, however, allows me to use satire and black humour to distance and relieve myself and my companions from this surreal situation – and on the way, to explore the unknown everyday reality of an activist".

Jana Shostak is an artist and an activist. She believes in the efficacy of art, solidarity, and the power of cooperation in culture. She became widely known as the co-creator of a time monument "A minute of shouting for Belarus". The winner of Paszport Polityki award for 2021.
