Before the screening, there will be a meeting dedicated to the culture of hearing-impaired people, translated into Polish Sign Language and led by Kinga Hołda-Justycka.

"Sonata", the moving story of Grzegorz Płonka, a boy wrongly diagnosed with autism, is based on true events. Late diagnosis of hearing loss reveals the boy's musical talent and, against all odds, he manages to make his dreams come true.

Diagnosed as an autistic child, Grzegorz lives in a hermetic world, unable to establish contact with others. During his teenage years, it turns out that the cause of isolation is not autism but hearing loss, which hides a great musical talent. Thanks to an auditory implant, Grześ begins to learn sounds, words and music, with which he falls in love. He wants to become a pianist and perform at the philharmonic hall. Although supported by modern technology, no one but himself and his closest family believes that a deaf boy will make his dream come true.
